Molecule Polarity - Polarity | Electronegativity | Bonds ...

Octanol is a polar molecule, like water is, while octane is a nonpolar molecule. Since octanol and water have the same molecular polarities, based on "like dissolves like", octanol will dissolve in water. On the other hand, octane and water do NOT have similar polarities, so octane will not dissolve in water.

What is molecular polarity in chemistry - Answers

Molecular polarity depends on the individual bond polarity as well as symmetry of the molecule. A polar molecule has either one polar bond or two or more bond dipoles that do not cancel. A nonpolar molecule has either all nonpolar bonds or two or more polar bonds that do cancel each other.

The overall polarity of molecules with more than one bond is determined from both the polarity of the individual bonds and the shape of the molecule. Each bond's dipole moment can be treated as a vector quantity,

having a magnitude and direction. Therefore the molecular polarity is the vector sum of the individual bond dipoles.

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Why does molecular polarity occur - Answers

Polarity is like a game of tug-o-war. If there is an equal "pull" on the central atom from all sides, then the molecule is nonpolar. If there is an unequal "pull" on the central atom because of unshared electrons, then the molecule is polar. Water is a polar molecule.

How does molecular shape affect polarity - Answers

Molecular Polarity The molecular geometry determines whether a molecule with polar bonds will be polar or nonpolar. Polarity of bonds results from the difference in electronegativity between atoms that share electrons. The greater the difference in electronegativity between bonded atoms, the greater the bond dipole.
