To create new user in SQL Server Management Studio 17, Open SSMS and connect to the SQL Server as a System Administrator. This can be done by logging on locally using Windows Authentication, or externally by using the 'sa' credentials. In Object Explorer, Right click on "Security" in the left pane, and select "New", then "Logins".

Using SQL Server Management Studio To set a database to single-user mode. In Object Explorer, connect to an instance of the SQL Server Database Engine, and then expand that instance. Right-click the database to change, and then click Properties. In the Database Properties dialog box, click the Options page. From the Restrict Access option, select Single. If other users are connected to the database, an Open Connections message will appear. To change the property and close all other ...

Sql Server Management Studio User

To specify the database in Management Studio, in the Connect to dialog box, click Options, and then click the Connection Properties tab. Select SQL user with password or a SQL user with login based on a SQL Server authentication login, when the person connecting cannot authenticate with Windows.

Set a Database to Single-user Mode - SQL Server ...

Connect to your database as your Remote Desktop user. SQL Server Management studio should load this automatically. On the folder tree on the left, expand Security. Right-click the Logins folder, then click New Login. Type the username you want to create into the Login name field. Select SQL Server Authentication. Enter and confirm a password for that user.

Create User using SQL Server Management Studio You will be creating a user for the EDU_SQL database. Connect to SQL Server then expand the Databases folder from the Object Explorer. Identify the database for which you need to create the user and expand it.

From my experience, if the computer running Management Studio isn't in the same domain (or trusted domain) as the SQL server, you can't use Windows Authentication to connect to the SQL server.
