The Passion Week begins with the anointing of Yahushua by Mary Magdalene, an appropriate place to start since Mary will be our star witness in documenting the details of the burial and resurrection. All four gospels contain a story of a woman anointing Yahushua: Matthew 26:6-13; Mark 14:3-9; Luke 7:36-50; John 12:1-9
